The scholarship is awarded to a college student who has demonstrated knowledge, understanding and commitment to diversity and inclusion through their course of study and involvement in local community service activities. Nominees are required to be 18-years or older, currently enrolled as a college junior or senior, with a grade point average over 3.0.
